**LOCAL FAIR ENTRY BLANKS MUST BE FILED BY SATURDAY**

Entry blanks for all exhibit classifications for the Southwest Georgia Fair to be held Oct. 11-16 at Albany Airport must be received by Saturday morning, Ralph Allison, General Manager of the Fair Association, said today.

Entries must be tabulated in order to provide exhibit facilities at the fairgrounds, he said. He added that entries received after Saturday morning will be accepted at the discretion of the committee in charge of the classifications.

Cattle, hogs, and poultry classifications entry blanks may be returned to J. D. Davis, Agricultural Agent, 122 ½ N. Jackson St., or direct to the Fair Association, Box 132, Albany.

Mrs. Fannie Mae Griner, Chairman of the Girls Clubs and Home Demonstration Activities, said her committee would try to accept entries until noon of Oct. 11.

For the first time in the seven-year history of the fair, local school children will be given holidays to attend, Mr. Allison said.

White children will attend on Oct. 13 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., while Negro children will attend Oct. 14 from 2 to 6 p.m. Both groups will attend on Oct. 16 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Gate admission on "School Day" will be 10 cents and all rides for school children will be 10 cents, Mr. Allison said.
