

FAIR RULES AND REGULATIONS

SECURITY AND SAFETY

Security and safety are the top concerns for all visitors at the Southwest Georgia Regional Fair (sponsored by the Exchange Club of Albany Georgia. Surveillance security cameras will be in use over the fairgrounds during the 6-day run of the fair. This property is patrolled and under the jurisdiction of the Dougherty County Sheriff's Department and the Albany Police Department.

The Southwest Georgia Regional Fair (sponsored by the Exchange Club of Albany Georgia) reserves the right to search the following:

All Containers, packages, bags, backpacks, pocketbooks, cups, etc.;

Clothing, strollers, Your Person;

Any other objects deemed to be a carrier of any destructive or lethal device.

Not Permitted on the Fairgrounds:

Weapons of any type, even by permit holders;

Pets, other than trained service animals approved by American Disabilities Act;

Persons wearing clothing or jewelry which the Fair Management deems as offensive or gang related.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Please review prior to your visit to the fairgrounds:

Adhere to proper use of trash and recycling receptacles.

Appropriate attire (shirts, pants, or dresses, and shoes) required at all times.

No exposed underwear or baggy pants below waist.

No alcoholic beverages permitted on fairgrounds, including the parking lots.

No weapons (even by permit holders).

No disorderly, disruptive conduct or behavior that endangers others.
