4-H Pumpkin Decorating Contest

- ♣ Contest is open to Cloverleaf, Junior, and Senior 4-H'ers. Maximum of (2) 4-H'ers per pumpkin to decorate. 4-H'ers are permitted a younger sibling to assist if they are not of 4-H age/grade eligibility.
- ♣ 4-H'er(s) may decorate his/her pumpkin in a creative way, using props and decorations from home. Paint will be provided BUT 4-Her may bring their own paints.
- ♣ No carving tools will be permitted.
- ♣ One entry per 4-Her(s).
- ♣ Pumpkins should be lovable, mischievous, and humorous - not frightening. "Scary" witch or monster faced pumpkins will be disqualified.
- ♣ The entry artwork/decorating must be done by the 4-Her(s) assigned to that pumpkin. No adult assistance is allowed.
- ♣ No electricity will be available for hot glue guns.
- ♣ Pumpkins will be judged on creativity (10 pts), originality/presentation (10 pts), and craftsmanship [attention to detail and neat in appearance] (10 pts).

ALL PUMPKINS MUST BE PICKED UP AFTER THE FAIR ON SUNDAY OR MONDAY.

ANY PUMPKIN REMAINING AFTER 4 PM MONDAY, NOV 13TH, WILL BE DISPOSED OF.
